Message from Marling School & Stroud High School —Grammar School Test

The Regional Schools Commissioner (RSC), acting on behalf of the Secretary of State, agreed that the COVID-19 pandemic could be considered to be a major change in circumstances necessitating a change to the date of the grammar school test. This means that for students hoping to join the school in September 2021, the test date has been moved from Saturday 12 September 2020 to Saturday 17 October 2020.
