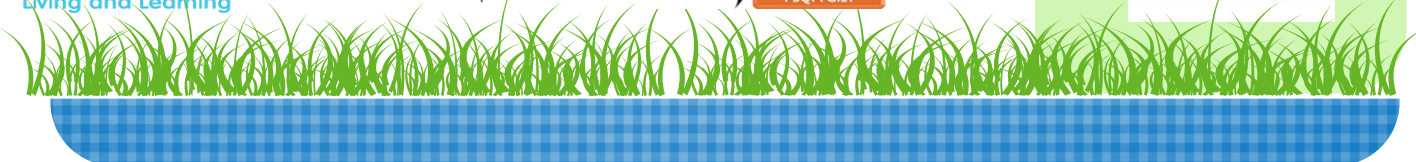
Y6 Language Taster Day
