### Pupils' Annual Reports

Parents will receive their child's annual report in the next couple of days by post. The reports are based on what your child has achieved in the autumn and spring terms. Teachers have used these assessments to predict whether your child was on track to achieve ARE (Age Related Expectations) before COVID-19 lockdown. The report also contains your child's attendance record for this period (September- March).
