

Progression and Expectations in MFL Vocabulary.

- Children should be using the correct MFL vocabulary from previous year groups as well as learning and using the correct vocabulary for their current year group.
- It is important that children understand the terms and can explain and define what they mean. This could be linked to English objectives and lessons; and thematic learning
- Unit specific vocabulary (detailed in the Language Angels unit plans) should be added to these lists by the class teacher and reviewed on an annual basis in line with the units to be taught in each academic year.
