Exciting News from CBAT!

CBAT have been informed by the DfE that they have received approval for their bid to build a new secondary school in Gloucester, and it can now proceed to the pre-opening stage, which the DfE has said "is a significant step towards opening the school". The new school will be a six form entry 11-16 comprehensive school serving its local community, with a total capacity of 900 pupils. The opening date in the bid was for September 2023 and CBAT will now work with the DfE and the LA to determine whether this is still achievable. This is a significant leap forward in the development of CBAT, who will now have a comprehensive and a selective secondary school alongside a primary and a junior school.
