### **Y6—Wellbeing Workshops**

On Friday 15th February, year 6 took part on some 'de-stress' workshops, run by Teens in Crisis. They learnt about what happens to the body when a person becomes stressed or anxious and were taught some helpful relaxation and mindfulness techniques.

Following the workshop, 96% of the pupils said that they knew strategies to help themselves if they felt stressed or anxious and had a better understanding of what happens to a person's body during stressful situations. The majority of pupils felt that what they had learnt at the workshop would help them cope better with stress and anxiety now and into the future.
