### Suncream:

Due to allergies within the school, children are not allowed to bring in their own bottles of suncream. Parents will need to apply before they come into school. For children with a medical need to have suncream applied more than once in the day, the office must be informed and allowances can then be made.

### Trim Trail:

Can we remind parents that until school starts children are still their responsibility to supervise. We are still seeing children on the trim trail unsupervised before school and this is obviously a safety issue.

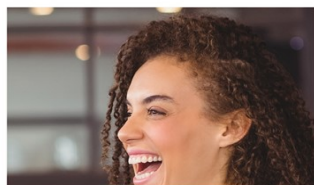
